The STAR Project is based on Evidenced Based Practices that prove that selected programs, services, and models do reduce recidivism. With your help, this project can make our community safer and more productive.

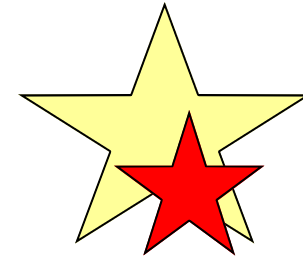
